

NYS Counties with Policies Restricting Smoking at Building Entrances

County	Policy
Albany	No smoking within 20 feet of county buildings
Broome	No smoking within 20 ft of entrances to county buildings
Cayuga	No smoking within 35 ft. for all county buildings, including the county office building
Chemung City of Elmira	No smoking within 25 ft of all the city buildings
Columbia	No smoking within 20 ft of county building entryways
Herkimer	Resolution in progress
Livingston	Smoking will not be allowed in buildings and on grounds owned and operated by Livingston County
Montgomery	No smoking at county building entrances
Oneida	Created a "smoking area" at the County Office building and there is no smoking allowed anywhere else on the grounds
Onondaga	No smoking within 25 ft of entrances and stairwells for all county-owned building and garages
Schuyler	No smoking 50 ft of county building entrances
St. Lawrence	No smoking within 25 ft of building entrances
Seneca	No smoking at entrances to county buildings
Suffolk	50 foot ban in front of all county buildings and hospitals
Tioga County	No use of any type of tobacco product at the Health and Human Services Building and Grounds. HHS is made up of Mental Hygiene DSS and the Health Department. The policy includes the walking trails
Tompkins City of Ithaca	Resolution in progress No smoking 25 ft of entrance for employees
Ulster City of Kingston	No smoking within 50 ft from entrances and exits of all city buildings
Warren	No smoking within 25 ft of county buildings including community college
Washington	No smoking within 25 ft of county buildings
Yates	No smoking policy for county workers at building entrances
